CLINICAL POLICIES updated PROCEDURES OF LIMITED CLINICAL VALUE POLICIES

The NHS Evidence Based Interventions (EBI) guidance is to assist CCG's in fulfilling their duties relating to securing continuous improvements in the quality of services for patients and in outcomes, particularly regarding appropriate clinical interventions. The objective of this guidance is to support CCGs in their decision-making, to address unwarranted variation, and to provide national advice to make local clinical decision-making more appropriate.

In line with the group's principle of adopting NHS Evidence Based Interventions policies, where they are felt to be more restrictive than the

current Derby & Derbyshire policies, the following have been updated:

Knee Arthroscopy for Patients with Osteoarthritis	 Amended to adopt NHS EBI wording Addition of 'mechanical' to clarify the type of knee locking. Referral changed to physiotherapy and MDT MSK CATS Clarification on open access to MRI scan

NICE INTERVENTIONAL PROCEDURES GUIDANCE, DIAGNOSTIC PROCEDURES, AND MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIES GUIDANCE (IPGS, DTG, MTGS)

The Derby and Derbyshire CCG do not commission and will not fund any procedure or technology assessed by NICE under their IPG, MTG and DTG programmes unless:

 the provider has submitted a robust, evidenced based business case to the commissioner and this has been subsequently approved

AND

- the NICE IPG states 'use with standard arrangements for clinical governance, consent and audit'
- OR the NICE MTG states 'the case for adoption within the NHS as described is supported by the evidence'
- OR the NICE DTG makes a recommendation as an option for use

The following business cases were submitted to DDCCG. The business cases were reviewed and presented to CPAG. The outcomes include the following:

Business Case	
IPG611 Prostate Artery Embolisation as a treatment option for benign prostate hyperplasia (UHDB)	CPAG agreed that there is no clear evidence that the procedure will support better health, care and value for the population of Derbyshire
	 Business case declined - not commissioned. Awaiting revised version of business case with updated data (several trials are due to report data in 2020-2022)
MTG leg ulcer and diabetic foot ulcer pathway proposal to include UrgoStart and UrgoClean Ag dressings onto the formulary (UHDB)	CPAG accept the clinical aspects of business case which now needs to be considered by the diabetes working group who will ultimately decide how the business case will be ratified and implemented.
IPG271 Total Wrist Replacement (UHDB)	 CPAG have agreed to not commission in accordance with the DDCCG's IPG policy as this is classed as a special arrangement. Business case declined
IPG619 Superior capsular augmentation for massive rotator cuff tears (UHDB)	CPAG have agreed to not commission in accordance with the DDCCG's IPG policy as this is classed as a research arrangement. Rusiness case declined.
