Derby and Derbyshire CCG Position Statement:
Use of Imaging in Management of Morton's Neuroma

Statement

Derby and Derbyshire CCG has deemed that the use of imaging in the Management of Morton's Neuroma will not be routinely commissioned.

As Morton's Neuroma is essentially a clinical diagnosis, requesting scans such as ultrasound or MRI are not required in primary care as this does not alter the clinical management of the condition.

A referral to Podiatry should be undertaken in cases where patients' symptoms are refractory to conservative measures.

These commissioning intentions will be reviewed periodically. This is to ensure affordability against other services commissioned by the CCG
