## <u>Derby and Derbyshire ICB Position Statement</u> Commissioned with Restrictions Cosmetic Procedures

## **Statement**

NHS Derby & Derbyshire ICB will not routinely commission the following cosmetic procedures unless

part of treatment for post trauma,

part of planned reconstruction surgery e.g. cancer, part of the management of a congenital abnormality resulting in a serious health function deficit

or for an iatrogenic\* condition arising from treatment previously delivered in the NHS

- Calf Augmentation
- Cheek Implants
- Chin Implants
- Collagen Implant
- Earlobe repair
- Facelifts (Rhytidectomy) unless part of the treatment for facial nerve palsy, cutis laxa or pseudoxanthoma elasticum)
- · Fat grafts
- \*\*Lipectomy/Liposuction
- Nipple inversion

These commissioning intentions will be reviewed periodically. This is to ensure affordability against other services commissioned by the ICB.

<sup>\*</sup> The term 'iatrogenic condition' refers to a condition that was directly attributable to previous medical treatment. In this context, 'iatrogenic condition' specifically excludes known side effects of a treatment or possible complications which the patient would normally be notified about when they were informed of the benefits and risks when consenting to the original treatment."
