## Derby and Derbyshire CCG Position Statement for Exercise ECG screening for coronary heart disease

## Statement

Derby and Derbyshire CCG has deemed that exercise ECG should not be routinely commissioned to screen for coronary heart disease (CHD) in asymptomatic and low risk patients aged 19 years and over as it has a very low pre-test probability of identifying pathology.

The CCG's commissioning intentions will be reviewed periodically. This is to ensure affordability against other services commissioned by the CCG.
