Statement

NHS Derby and Derbyshire ICB has deemed that Surgical Correction of Adult Strabismus (Squint) should not routinely be commissioned for asymptomatic or non-functional* purposes

The ICB's commissioning intentions will be reviewed periodically. This is to ensure affordability against other services commissioned by the ICB.
