Statement

NHS Derby & Derbyshire ICB (NHS DDICB) will not routinely commission all facet joint injections. This includes facet joint injections for <u>diagnostic</u> purposes and for <u>treatment</u> purposes.

These commissioning intentions will be reviewed periodically. This is to ensure affordability against other services commissioned by the ICB.
